

Local artist Gayle Dennington Anderson will raise money for the relocation of the Geneva Soldiers and Sailors Monument, one drawing at a time.

Anderson has donated 10 sets of prints of eight original ink sketches she drew in 1986. The Geneva Federal Savings and Loan Association commissioned her to draw the sketches of local landmarks to display in the bank's lobby. The print sets are available for a \$75 donation toward the monument relocation. The sketches are of the Christian House on South Broadway; the Walnut Street House, former residence of Dr. James Merrill; the Belding Webster Building, currently the Behm Family Funeral Home; the former Geneva Public Library, now Western County Court; the Austinburg Church; the Geneva-on-the-Lake Strip; the former Geneva Post Office, now Hergenroeder Orthopedic Clinic; and the Soldiers and Sailors Monument.

Anderson also is selling individual prints for \$15. A \$45 donation buys four prints. Individual prints in square mats are available for \$25, \$30 for prints in oval mats, \$60 for four prints in square mats or \$100 for four prints in oval mats.
