ORDINANCE NO. 2961

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING SELECTED SUBSECTIONS OF CHAPTER 1042 SEWERS.

WHEREAS, The Superintendent for the Geneva Wastewater Department has made recommendations for modifications to selected subsections of Geneva Codified Ordinances Chapter 1042 SEWERS related to the efficient operation of Geneva Wastewater services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL, by the Council for the City of Geneva, Ohio, that the following subsections of Chapter 1042 SEWERS will be amended as follows:

SECTION I. Chapter 1042.02(a) shall be amended to read as follows:

1042.02(a) No person, corporation, partnership or association shall connect any building or any other structure, directly or indirectly, or expand or alter buildings with pre-existing connections in such a manner as to discharge more waste into the sanitary sewer unless they have obtained a sewer tap-in permit from the City Manager's Office at City Hall.

SECTION II. Chapter 1402.03(a) shall be amended to read as follows:

1042.03 PERMIT APPLICATION; FEES.

(a) For City residences or businesses: the base unit shall be the single-family, three-bedroom home with an average flow of 360 gallons per day. The fee for this unit shall be three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

(b) Non-City residents or businesses will be charged a 100% surcharge to the calculated City resident or business rate.

For all connections other than the single-family, three-bedroom residential, the average daily flow shall be determined from Table A-1 for Design Flow Requirements set forth in the Ohio Administrative Code 3745-42-05, a copy of which shall be maintained at the Office of Wastewater Treatment for reference (also available at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/rules/42-05.pdf>). In no event shall a tap-in fee within the City limits be less than this three thousand dollar (\$3,000) minimum.

(d) The design flow requirement for car washes shall be 500 gallons per bay.

The above operational procedures may vary in some instances and may not be all inclusive. Any variances must be approved by the City Manager.

(f) The sanitary sewer tapping permit fee shall be paid upon issuance of the permit. (Ord. 2246. Passed 1-8-90.)
