

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING GENEVA CODIFIED ORDINANCE §1042.03(C), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Joint Economic Development District I Agreement (JEDD I) between the City of Geneva and Harpersfield Township requires a modification to the sewer flow guide which is used to calculate tap-in fees for restaurants along the freeway,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL, by the Council for the City of Geneva, Ohio, that the following subsections of Chapter 1042 SEWERS will be amended as follows:

SECTION I. Chapter 1402.03(c) shall be amended to read as follows:

1042.03 PERMIT APPLICATION; FEES.

(c) (1) For all connections other than the single-family, three-bedroom residential, the average daily flow shall be determined from Table A-1 for Design Flow Requirements set forth in the Ohio Administrative Code 3745-42-05, a copy of which shall be maintained at the Office of Wastewater Treatment for reference (also available at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/rules/42-05.pdf>). In no event shall a tap-in fee within the City limits be less than this three thousand dollar (\$3,000) minimum.

(2) When applying Table A-1 for Design Flow Requirements, Item #3 under the Food-Service Operation/Restaurant section specifically shall not apply in a manner that would require a design flow of 100 gallons per seat for calculating tap-in fees. Other Food-Service Operation/Restaurant design flow guides may apply.

SECTION II. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the reason that the JEDD 1 Agreement requires this amendment to the flow guide, and for the general preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the City.
